

## Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC)

Extended until 12/31/03

### Who can benefit?

- Employers who hire eligible workers can save on payroll expenses with a WOTC tax credit.
- Eligible jobseekers become more attractive candidates for job openings.

### Eligible Target Groups

- Qualified TANF welfare recipient for 9 months within the last 18 months, ending on hire date.
- Qualified veteran food stamp recipient for 3 month period within last 15 months, ending on hire date.
- Qualified ex-felon member of a low income family.
- 18-24 year old residing in a federal empowerment zone/enterprise community.
- Individual referred by the State rehabilitation agency or VA rehabilitation office.
- Qualified summer youth residing in federal empowerment zone/enterprise community.
- 18-24 year old food stamp recipient (or family member) for last 6 months (or 3 of last 5 months if eligibility ceased) ending on hire date.
- Individual certified as receiving Social Security Supplemental Security Income for any month ending in 60 day period ending on hire date.

### How much is the tax credit?

#### WOTC: 2-Tiered Tax Credit for 1 Year

- Tier 1: 25% of first \$6,000 in qualified wages if WOTC eligible employee works at least 120 hours but less than 400 hours to a maximum of \$1,500.
- Tier 2: 40% of first \$6,000 in qualified wages if WOTC eligible employee works 400 hours or more to a maximum of \$2,400.

#### Welfare-to-Work: 2-Year Tax Credit

The WtW eligible employee must be employed at least 180 days or 400 hours in the year for which the credit is claimed:

- Year 1: 35% of the first \$10,000 in qualified wages to a maximum of \$3,500.
- Year 2: 50% of the first \$10,000 in qualified wages to a maximum of \$5,000.

## Welfare-to-Work Tax Credit (WtW)

Extended to 12/31/03

### Eligible target groups:

- TANF recipient for at least 18 consecutive months ending on the hiring date; or
- TANF recipient whose eligibility expired under federal/state law after August 5, 1997 for applicants hired within 2 years after their eligibility expired; or
- A recipient who received family assistance for a total of 18 months after August 5, 1997 and has a hire date not more than 2 years after the end of the earliest 18 month period.

### How to Apply for the WOTC and WtW Tax Credit

If an employer believes the potential employee is eligible within the target group, submit the following forms which are available at any WDD office:

- **IRS Form 8850:** complete the bottom portion and have the employee complete the top portion.
- **Submit the form:** Within 21 days of the job start, the form must be submitted to a local WDD office.
- **ETA Form 9061:** Expedite the process by attaching this form and any other documentation with the IRS form.
